**The safety** of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Puppies** under 6 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**All dogs** must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

**Bitches in season** shall not be eligible to participate. The Club will refund all but \$9 of the entry fee upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season or the dog is unable to compete due to injury. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund prior to the start of the trial.

**Move-Up Regulations** Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner. For moveups prior to the trial, this request must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6PM, Monday, April 26, before the trial. For day-to-day move-ups, this request must be made by 4PM at the trial site the day preceding the move-up. This request must be written. Emails are acceptable notification.

#### **OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club.

#### **COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk through period will be held prior to each class.

**A warm-up area**, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

#### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This Agility Trial is open to all Papillions over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC ILP or PAL number. Dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect their physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

#### **Height Divisions**

**Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.** Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Dogs in the Preferred class **MUST** run in their proper height class.

**Entry forms:** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded or entries cancelled in event of such errors after the published closing date. Please TYPE or PRINT CAREFULLY the information on the entry form to minimize errors. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express Mail and delivery service entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature. Call or e-mail Trial Secretary for delivery information. Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with Agreement and instructions attached cannot be accepted.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a Judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Treasurer will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
